Using the Cut Gauge Line




Use the Cut Gauge Line on the Quick-Connect® body to locate and mark the cable for proper trim length. This is typically used when attaching the second in a pair of end fittings.




Stretch the cable tight. Mark with felt pen at Cut Gauge Line.



at the mark.



Insert cable as far as it wil go into fitting. If cable is too long, remove it using a Release Tool and trim as needed.



Quick-Connect® Jaws lock onto cable automatically. Tighten the cable line using the tenson adjustment fitting.

Installing Quick-Connect® Pivot Fitting

The Pivot Fitting is comprised of a Quick-Connect® body and a stainless steel Hanger Bolt. The Hanger Bolt needs to be installed prior to the Quick-Connect® body. DO NOT attempt to install the Hanger Bolt with the Quick-Connect® Fitting attached, or you may damage the fitting.



Spin Hanger Bolt Installation Tool onto the end of the bolt.



Drill 7/64" pilot hole. Harder woods may need larger hole.



Spin Quick-Connect® onto Hanger Bolt until it bottoms out.



Drive Hanger Bolt into post using 7/16" socket or electric drill with 1/2" chuck.



Insert cable all the way into Quick-Connect® fitting until it stops. Jaws will lock automatically.



Drive until threaded section protrudes approx. 1/2" from post face.



Apply a high strength thread locking compound to threads.



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
